Councillors' Reports

Jo Docherty

- JD discussed bin collections, potholes, Newlands Park tennis courts being refurbished

Kyle Thornton

- KT discussed friends of Newlands Park, wee green grant, support from Lawn Tennis Club - voted on by public - no link from ENV2 fund.
- Bins, Green bin collection is being changed to every 3 weekly, purple bins changed to every 8 weeks Blue bins remain at every 2 weeks and brown bins remain at every 2 weeks. This is only for front and back door premises. New collections dates tbc. Letters will be coming out on how to maximise recycling. People can request an additional blue bin free of charge.
- Traffic calming scheme around Newlands Park.
- Road defects have crept back up after poor weather, snow and ice over Winter. Issues can be reported through the GCC online system.
- Lighting faults are currently taking 60 - 90 days to repair faults. Issues around the availability of trained staff. JD has since sent on this link to the map -
